



PROMARES aims at tackling the challenges hampering the full-fledged development of the potential for maritime and multimodal freight transport in the Programme Area. Its main objective is therefore to enhance cross-border maritime and multimodal freight transport by involving transport stakeholder and policy makers facing the same cross-border challenges, from both a strategic and operational perspective, through the increased cooperation among them.

The project involves 12 partners and it is led by the Port Network Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea.



### **The pilot action of the Port of Venice**

The Port of Venice developed the re-engineering of the existing Integrated System for the Management of the Railway Shunting (SIMA): new functionalities have been implemented and now the SIMA2 can better interoperate with some IT systems used by port communities, such as the Infrastructure Manager, Railway Undertakings and Terminals.
